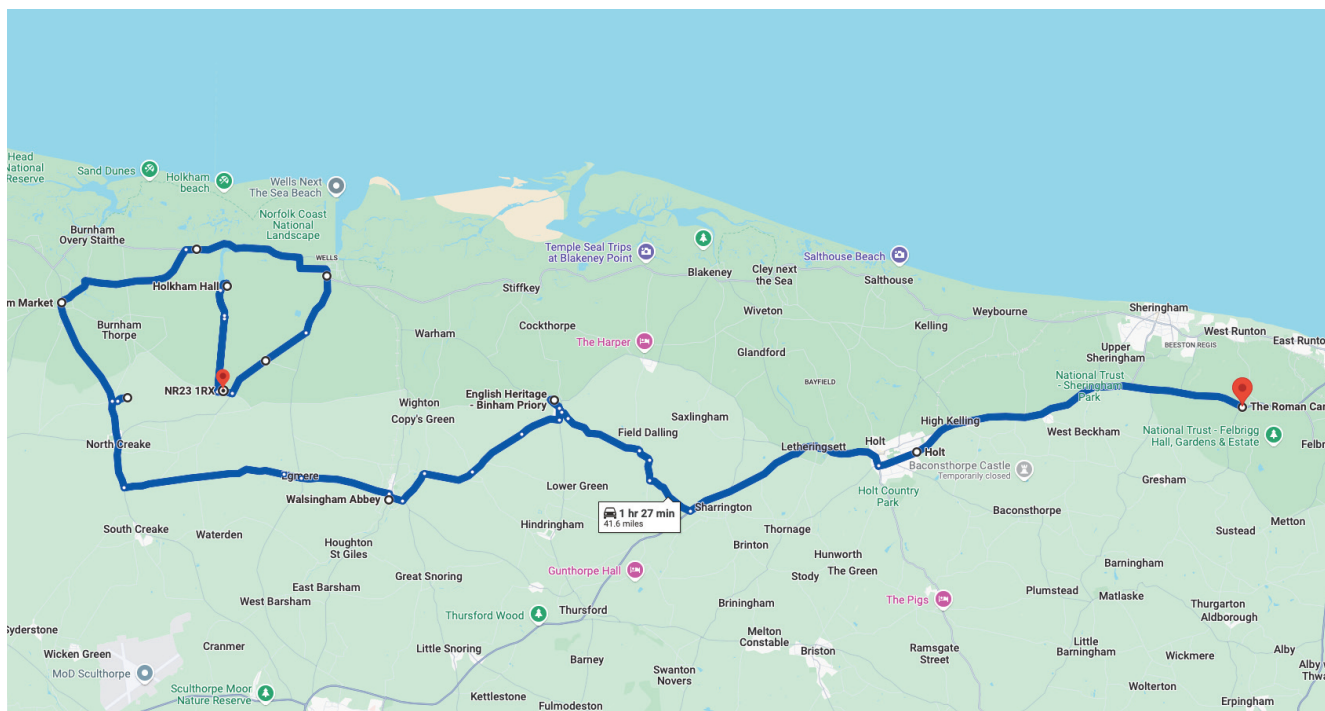


TSSC Norfolk Roman Camp Inn to Holkham Hall Run



Start from Roman Camp Inn, Holt Rd, Aylmerton, NR11 8QD 10-10.30am.

Ending at Holkham Hall, South Drive, NR23 1RX between 12.30 and 1.30pm (modern cars to use the main car park)

The route is approximately 40 miles and should take around 1 1/2 hours. There's plenty of time to stop at some of the points of interest you go past but please keep an eye on the clock. You need to be at Holkham Hall between **12.30 and 1.30pm**.

This is **NOT** a timed event, rather an enjoyable amble around the boundary of Norfolk. All timings are approximate and allow enough time to be able to drive sensibly.

You are advised to comply with all Road Traffic Regulations and Speed Limits.

Some roads are narrow with blind bends. Please be careful of horses, cyclists and walkers.

We advise entrants not to bunch up or form convoys and to respect other road users.

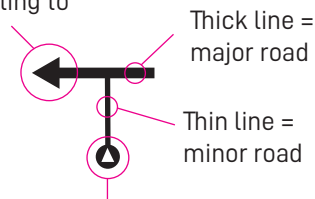
Everybody wants to travel at their own speed - if you find a trail of Triumphs behind you please pull over and let them pass.

Most of the junctions are give way, so you don't have to worry too much until you come to a stop.

Junctions that go from a major to a minor road, which you will need to look out for, are marked

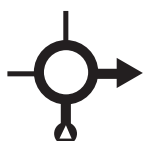
Directions



Turn left out of the hotel onto A148, through, Bodham and High Kelling and into Holt (6¹/₂ miles)



Go straight over roundabout signed Kings Lynn, Holt A148



Turn right at roundabout signed Kings Lynn A148 and carry on through Letheringsett



Carry on PAST right hand turn for Blakeney, Langham B1156



...and turn right at crossroads away from Sharrington



Shortly after take right hand fork signed Field Dalling and Langham



Turn right at give way (unsigned)



At Field Dalling turn left signed Binham



At give way go straight over staggered cross roads. Signed Warham, Binham Priory



Turn right into **Binham Priory** (NR21 0DQ) Coffee/cafe, The Parlour, or continue straight on



Turn right out of Binham Priory

As you come out of Binham take left fork signed Wighton and past National Speed Limit sign



After 2 miles enter 30mph limit and turn left at red postbox, signed Walsingham



Enter Gt Walsingham and turn right at give way (unsigned)



Turn right at give way signed Wells, Fakenham and continue into **Walsingham with Abbey** (NR22 6BP)



Turn right at give way towards car park
Enter car park if staying (charges apply). On exiting follow signs out of car park and turn left at give way missing out the next direction



Turn left at give way (unsigned)



Go straight over crossroads with B1105 (unsigned)



After 3 miles turn right at give-way



Go through North Creake and turn right into **Creake Abbey Ruins** (NR21 9LF) or continue straight on



Turn right out of Creake Abbey Ruins



Turn right and then straight on at 2 give-ways signed Wells, Docking, Bircham B1155

Turn right at give way to stay on B1155 signed Cromer



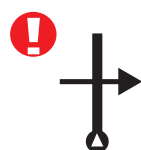
Turn right at give-way onto A149 signed Cromer, Wells



Triumphs DO NOT take the right turn into Holkham Hall main entrance, rather continue on A149. Moderns please use this car park



After 3 miles turn right signed New Holkham, Holkham Hall Coaches



Follow wall on right and turn right signed The Burnhams, Holkham Hall Coaches



Turn right into Holkham Park signed Holkham Studios, Longlands (NR23 1RX)
Go through gates and follow road past obelisk and drop down into park to park up in front of hall

Note the gate to Holkham Hall will be manned between 12.30pm and 1.30pm.

Binham Priory Impressive Monastic ruins, with the Parlour cafe and dairy shop

Walsingham Abbey Grounds and ruins of medieval priory. £6.50 entrance charge

Creake Abbey Ruins Flint walled ruins of an Augustinian abbey struck by fire and the plague. In the courtyard next door are toilets, craft shops and cafe

Holkham Hall 18th-century country house with large grounds and access to beach. Constructed for the First Earl of Leicester

Restaurants include the Lookout and Courtyard Café.

Holkham Park is included in your parking ticket.

Walled Garden (£7), Holkham Stories (£7), Walled Garden and Holkham Stories combined (£10)

Holkham Hall, home of the first Earl of Leicester and still owned by the family. Open to the public with fine rooms, galleries, chapel, libraries, and state bedrooms. Entrance fee £18.
